

# Anyone Can Be Diagnosed With Breast Cancer



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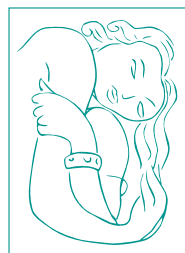
I've treated thousands of women for breast cancer but that doesn't mean I am immune. I know that. Yet, who can really be prepared for breast cancer?
