### *New radiologist joins Montclair Breast Center*

The Montclair Breast Center, 37 North Fullerton Ave., announced recently that Melissa Lee, M.D., a board-certified radiologist, has been appointed to the position of clinical breast radiologist.

Lee's primary responsibility will be to help organize and manage the center's new Breast Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) suite, slated to open in 2004, as well as to supervise the day-to-day operations and consult with patients.

She will work closely with Dr. Nancy Elliott, the center's founder and director, and Dr. William Ko, director of breast imaging, and the professional breast care staff.

Prior to joining the center, Lee was a clinical assistant radiologist at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. She received her board certification from the American Board of Radiology in 2001 and was licensed by New York State as a physician in 1997.

Her postdoctoral training included: *Breast and Body Imaging Fellowship* at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, *Diagnostic Radiology Residency*, Montefiore Medical Center and a Preliminary Year of Internal Medicine at Beth Israel Medical Center.

Lee earned her medical degree from Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York and has a bachelor's degree from Wellesley College in Massachusetts.
