Breast cancer diagnostic techniques topic of upcoming lecture

NEWTON - Newton Memorial Hospital's Breast Support Group will be hosting a lecture titled "Ductal Lavage and Digital Mammography: State of the Art Diagnostic Techniques," presented by Doctor Nancy Elliott, director of Montclair Breast Center

The lecture will take place from 6:30 to 7:30 p.m., Oct. 12, at the Sparta Health and Wellness, located at 89 Sparta Avenue, Sparta

Dr. Elliott is a fellowship-trained breast surgeon who started practicing in Montclair in 1989. She completed training in breast disease at UMD-MJ/ Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital.

She received her medical degree from Mount Sinai Medical Center and completed a general surgery residency at St. Vincent's Hospital, both in New York City.

Dr. Elliott graduated with honors from Barnard College, Columbia University.

She is well known not only for medical expertise in the field of breast disease evaluation and treatment, but particularly for her sensitivity and commitment to her patients.

She has been honored by the New Jersey General Assembly and Montclair Economic Development Council as "Outstanding Woman of the Year in Science," for her distinction as the founder and director of the Montclair Breast Center and as a "superlative physician who exemplifies the spirit of caring and compassion."
